

**Contract Title:** Sedgwick Road (SR 160) Sewer and Water Main

**Description:**

West Sound Utility District has contracted with the Washington State Department of Transportation to have the WSDOT contractor the water and sewer mains in the SR 160 road widening. It will be very difficult for the District to access its water and sewer mains in the State highway once the road widening is completed. By doing this work now, the District will be in a better position to serve the expanding urban population.

The work shall consist of almost 4,000 feet of new 6-inch and 8-inch sewer main in Sedgwick Road. It will extend from Brasch Road to Kerry Lane and will connect to the new Converse Avenue Sewer Main and Pump Station.

Also included is 5,411 feet of new 12-inch water main from the vicinity of Fred Meyers to Phillips Road. This water main replaces older 8-inch mains that currently serve the neighborhood.

The Public Works Trust Fund has loaned the District \$1,358,130 for 75% of the Converse Avenue and Sedgwick Road sewer main cost. WSDOT is paying the District \$130,000 for having 15 homes connected to the sewer main. (The project adversely affected the homes' drain fields and WSDOT decided to connect them to sewer rather than purchase the property or pay for an alternative on-site sewer system.) The District sold revenue bonds in 2009 to finance the remaining project costs.
