Contract Title: Well 22

Description:

Well 22 is the next new well for the District and is one of the most important projects in the District. It will require a well 1,580 feet deep and construction commenced in April 2010. Before construction started, the site was surveyed, selective clearing was completed, and the driveway widened to accommodate the specialized drilling equipment.

Well 21 draws water from a particular productive aquifer and the District sought to have the new Well 22 served by the same deep aquifer. By having Nicholson Drilling from Port Orchard deepen Well 9, we verified the targeted aquifer is there and the production contract was awarded.

After the well has been drilled and tested, a future contract in 2011 will be needed to connect the well to the water system.
