



How to Get Your Rebate?

**Pressure Reducing

Rebate Application**

- ◆ Be a residential customer in good standing with the District.
- ◆ Provide proof of purchase in the form of a sales receipt or purchase invoice.
- ◆ Provide physical inspection of the new PRV by a District representative to confirm the make and model of the valve.
- ◆ Complete an application, enclose a copy of your receipt, and mail it to:

Retain a copy of the completed rebate application for your records. The Sales Receipt must be dated after May 6th, 2008, with the name of the seller clearly indicated. Your rebate will be credited to your account within 60 days after receipt and verification. West Sound Utility District may take such action as is reasonably necessary to verify the accuracy of statements made in the application prior to payment rebate.

This offer is valid for residential purchased after May 6th, 2008. Each household is limited to a rebate of up to \$100.00 for purchasing a PRV when the property never had one. The rebate is limited to the purchase cost of PRV, up to a maximum of \$100. Labor or other materials are not included. Each household is limited to a rebate of up to \$100.00 for replacing a PRV when the property has one and there has not been a District PRV paid in the last five years of the application. The rebate is limited to the purchase cost of the PRV, up to a maximum of \$100.00. Labor or other materials are not included. The District shall provide one plastic meter box for housing the PRV at not cost to the rate payer.

West Sound Utility District Water Conservation Rebate Program

- ◆ Customer shall be in good standing in payment of all District billings and in compliance with all duly enacted regulations at time of application, and when the PRV was purchased.
- ◆ Customer shall be a residential customer of the District (apartments, condominiums, commercial establishments, or multiple duplexes on a single water meter do not currently qualify).
- ◆ The PRV used shall be permanently located in a qualifying residence within the District's service area.
- ◆ The PRV shall have been purchased on or after May 6th, 2008.
- ◆ Customer shall provide proof of purchase in the form of a sales receipt or purchase invoice.
- ◆ Customer shall allow for physical inspection of the new PRV by a District representative to confirm the make and model of the valve.
- ◆ Rebate amount is currently established at the cost of the PRV up to \$100.00.
- ◆ The rebate shall be applied to the customer's utility bill for the property affected.
